Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

The County of San Benito encourages all high school students to become involved in the election process. One of the most rewarding ways to do this, is by becoming an Election Officer. State law allows high school students who are in good academic standing, and at least 16 years of age, to serve as an Election Officers on Election Day. All students that are placed will be required to attend an 8 hour training prior to Election Day.

Students will serve with 5-7 additional Election Officers, including Elections Department Staff. Students are expected to be at their assigned Vote Center location from 7 am to approximately 6pm on Saturday, Sunday and Monday. On Tuesday, Election Day, students will be expected to be at their assigned Vote Center from 6am to approximately 9pm. Students are responsible for providing their own transportation to and from the Vote Center and bring their own lunch/snacks. The San Benito County Elections Department will to assign a Vote Center location that will be in close proximity to the student's home. Students are paid the same as other poll workers through stipends. Stipends are mailed 6-8 weeks following the election.

Each High School Student will benefit from this program in several ways:

- Hands-on experience of learning how local elections are conducted
- Receive training on how to open a polling place, process voters, and close the polls
- Inspiration to vote when they reach 18 years of age
- Gain a lifelong appreciation for the democratic process

In order to be considered for this program, students must complete the following: High School Student Election Officer Volunteer form, Parent/Guardian Consent Form/ Liability Release, Teacher(s) Consent form, and Principal Consent form.

Once the High School Election Officer Application (Student's Information, Parent/Guardian Consent Form & Liability Release, and Teacher(s) Consent Form) is completed, the student must turn in the application to their High School's Clerk's Office. The principal will review the application prior to be approved. If approved, the High School's Clerk's Office will enter the student's name into the school's attendance system and notify the student of approval. After school approval, the student is responsible for turning in the completed application to the San Benito County Elections Department. If student is selected, parents will be required to call the School's Clerk's Office to call out their child and verify their participation.

5. JOB DESCRIPTION, SCHEDULE & STIPEND INFORMATION

Election Officers are responsible for setting up and closing Vote Centers, assist voters with the different methods of casting their vote, ensure transparency and security with all election processes and procedures.

Election Officers are required to report to their assigned Vote Center daily from 7:00am to 6:00pm, and on Election Day from 6:00am to 9:00pm.

Stipend includes compensation for 4 days (Saturday-Tuesday), including Election Day assignment and attending a mandatory training.
